

WASTE REMOVAL POLICY STATEMENT

General Statement:

Due to the diverse nature of construction activities that J Coffey Construction Ltd. engages, a wide variety of wastes are produced and collected, ranging from general wastes and recyclable materials, through to special and hazardous waste. J Coffey Construction Ltd. recognises its duty to ensure that all waste is disposed of responsibly, using approved registered waste contractors.

Our intention to develop by minimising the production of waste, through good purchasing practice of materials and reuse and recycle materials whenever practical to do so.

To ensure we consider our environmental and waste management responsibilities and to assist in the minimisation of waste and the recycling of materials wherever practicable; systems and procedures will be implemented to encourage the recycling of material with an intent to minimising the overall levels of waste we produce.

Policy Objectives:

- To ensure that waste management is performed in accordance with waste legislative requirements, including the duty of care, and to plan for future legislative changes and to mitigate their effects.
- To minimise waste generation at source and facilitate repair, reuse and recycling over the disposal of wastes, where it is cost effective.
- To provide clearly defined roles and responsibilities to identify and co-ordinate each activity within the waste management chain.
- To promote environmental awareness to increase and encourage waste minimisation, reuse and recycling.
- To ensure the safe handling and storage of wastes.
- To provide appropriate training for staff on waste management issues.
- To promote all sites to have a Waste Marshal.

Further Aims:

To further meet our objectives, we will employ the services of a reputable waste removal company who will collect our waste and dispose of at one of their recycling facilities.

All of our projects undergo an environmental site inspection, where waste management is monitored to ensure all waste is responsibly removed from site and all waste docket information retained is compliant, with relevant European Waste Code (EWC) number, waste stream description, location of waste disposal & vehicle registration number.

J Coffey Construction recognises its duty of care to ensure all wastes including controlled & hazardous, are disposed in accordance with the Environmental Protection Act 1990 Section 34, which imposes a Duty of Care' on all producers and handlers of waste 'to take reasonable measures to prevent the unauthorised deposit, treatment or disposal of waste'.

In a further move to meet the Circular Economy culture that looks to repurpose & reuse materials, equipment, furniture etc. J Coffey Construction Ltd. have produced a Circular Economy Strategy along with engaging the service of Excess Materials Exchange (EME), to enable registration of products and materials on an online platform, to enable interested parties to purchase or request said items for reuse or repurposing to avoid waste to landfill.
